


# WHY IMPROVE MARC RECORDS




# **CIRCULATION SOFTWARE**

#### Pros:

- Easy to use because it's familiar
- Z39.50 already set up

#### Cons:

- Bad for changing multiple records at once
- Working with live data



# **KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS**


Example: QuickTextPaste

#### Pros:

- Saves you from typing the same thing over and over
- Free

#### Con:

Takes time to set up




### **MARCEdit**

#### Pros:

- Free
- Recorded trainings available online
- Powerful can edit multiple records at once

#### Cons:


- Steep Learning Curve
- Difficult to know what was changed in your records
- Slow



#### What can you do?


- Find records using Z39.50
- Change single records
- Batch edit and update
- Update to RDA

### C# MARC Editor

- Free
- Hasn't been updated since 2018
- If you learn one free software, learn MARCEdit.



# FULL-SERVICE CATALOGING COMPANIES

(i.e. OCLC Cataloging Service, MARCive and Backstage)

#### Pros

- Fast
- Easy someone else does all the work

#### Cons

- Becomes expensive if doing more than a few records
- Usually priced on the complexity of the fix or per record

# **BestMARC**

#### Pros:

- Can use for initial cataloging
- Great for fixing problems in catalog
- Can quickly update records from AACR2 to RDA
- Can fix or update multiple records at one time (batch editing)
- It's prettier than the free options
- Has a free diagnosis to evaluate catalog

#### Cons:

- The software itself is not free
- Once you know about the problems, you'll want to fix them


# AnalyzeMARC

**AnalyzeMARC** – service that analyzes MARC Record metadata and provides a Data Diagnostic Report






### **BATCH EDITING**

Batch editing (updating multiple records at once)...

- Add, remove or change information in similar records
- Saves time
- Great for making small changes that affect a lot of records





 Having a workflow that checks RDA compliance and then updates award records




